Job Summary:

The ICC Kids Assistant Director is responsible for building a team that leads and executes ICC Kids ministry by inspiring others to serve in ICC Kids. The ICC Kids Assistant Director will also be responsible for working with the ICC Kids Director to foster an environment conductive to excellence and safety in the ICC Kids ministry. Additionally, this role will oversee volunteer orientation and training that includes appropriate placement of volunteers based on their personal gifts and passions.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- I. Build an ICC Kids ministry team
 - Recruit people through the vision of ICC Kids on the weekends
 - Make sure leaders and rooms are set up and ready to serve on the weekends
 - Connect with ICC Kids leaders weekly via phone call or in person
 - Help ensure the overall operations of the weekend is meeting all expectations
 - Oversee volunteer orientation and training that includes appropriate placement of volunteers
 - Oversee ICC Kids video recordings
 - Schedule and recruit leaders for video recordings
- II. Maintain a positive ICC Kids environment to establish excellence in the ministry
 - Communicate daily with the ICC Kids Director
 - Balance tasks and relational aspects of the role
 - Work with the ICC Kids Director to help reach all listed goals required
 - Lead day-to-day operations of the ministry
 - Oversee all operations on Sunday for all services

- Must exemplify a high level of passion about sharing ICC Kids vision with our community
- Facilitate on-going training and coaching for volunteers.
- Ability to stay organized and can maintain administrative duties

Working Conditions and Requirements:

This position receives general direction while working from established policies and objectives. This position plans and carries out assignments and will resolve most situations that arise. Completed work is generally monitored only to determine the effectiveness in meeting position/team objectives. This role works in a fast-paced environment with multiple interruptions. It is essential for this role to balance daily responsibilities while maintaining a high level of concentration and stress tolerance. The physical activity of this job includes sitting, standing, and walking for an extended period of time. This role regularly communicates through talking and hearing and must be able to do so efficiently and effectively. At ICC, every staff member and intern is a minister, and is expected to fully engage in the ministry of the church. We consider ministry readiness, and an individual's capacity to represent ICC's beliefs as a minister, during the selection process for all staff and intern positions. An essential function within every position held by a staff member or intern at ICC is to uphold and represent ICC and our beliefs in all areas of personal and professional life.
